Who qualifies: All low/moderate income taxpayers (less than \$54,000 per year)
Retirees with moderate incomes

Services provided: Federal (1040s) and North Carolina tax returns on a first-come, first-served basis.

You must bring:

- Social Security cards for you, your spouse, and all dependents
- Last year's tax returns
- Photo identification
- Form 1095-A for insurance purchases through the Market Place
- Any tax forms or other information received from the IRS
- Wage and earnings statement forms W-2, W-2G, and 1099-R
- Interest, dividend, tuition, and mortgage forms 1099 and 1098
- Childcare provider information
- Birthdates for you, your spouse, and all dependents
- Bank routing numbers and account numbers for direct deposit
